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## Present Indefinite:

**Identity:** تا ہے، تی ہے، تے ہیں

### Formula:

**Assertive:** Subject + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form + Objective

**Negative:** Subject + Do/Does not + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form + Objective

**Interrogative:** Do/Does + Subject + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form + Objective + ?

**Interro-Negative:** Do/Does + Subject + Not + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form + Objective + ?

- With He, She, It, Name (Singular) "DOES" comes and verb will be used as plural. We add s/es with the verb. In making negative or interrogative sentences after using "DOES" omit the s/es from the verb.
- With I, We, You, They, Them etc. (Plural) "DO" comes and verb will be used as singular.

### Example:

اسد اسکول جاتا ہے۔ (Singular)

**Assertive/Affirmative Sentence:**

Asad goes to school.

**Negative Sentence:**

Asad does not go to school.

**Interrogative Sentence:**

Does Asad go to school?

**Interro-Negative Sentences:**

Does Asad not go to school?

وہ اسکول جاتے ہیں۔ (Plural)

**Assertive/Affirmative Sentence:**

They go to school.

**Negative Sentence:**

They do not go to school.

**Interrogative Sentence:**

Do they go to school?

**Interro-Negative Sentences:**

Do they not go to school?

## Present Continues:

**Identity:** رہا ہے، رہی ہے، رہیں ہیں

### Formula:

**Assertive:** Subject + Helping Verb + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective

**Negative:** Subject + Helping Verb + not + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective

**Interrogative:** Helping Verb + Subject + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective + ?

**Interro-Negative:** Helping Verb + Subject + Not + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective + ?

**Helping Verbs: IS, AM, ARE**

- With He, She, It, Name (Singular) "IS" comes.
- With I "AM" Comes.
- With We, You, They, Them etc. (Plural) "ARE" comes.

### Example:

اسد اسکول جا رہا ہے۔

**Assertive/Affirmative Sentence:**

Asad is going to school.

**Negative Sentence:**

Asad is not going to school.

**Interrogative Sentence:**

Is Asad going to school?

**Interro-Negative Sentences:**

Is Asad not going to school?

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## Present Perfect:

**Identity:** چکا ہے، چکی ہے، چکے ہیں

### Formula:

**Assertive:** Subject + Helping Verb + Verb 3<sup>rd</sup> Form + Objective

**Negative:** Subject + Helping Verb + not + Verb 3<sup>rd</sup> Form + Objective

**Interrogative:** Helping Verb + Subject + Verb 3<sup>rd</sup> Form + Objective + ?

**Interro-Negative:** Helping Verb + Subject + Not + Verb 3<sup>rd</sup> Form + Objective + ?

**Helping Verbs:** HAS, HAVE

- With He, She, It, Name (Singular) "HAS" comes.
- With I, We, You, They, Them etc. (Plural) "HAVE" comes.

### Example:

اسد اسکول جا چکا ہے۔

**Assertive/Affirmative Sentence:** Asad has gone to school.

**Negative Sentence:** Asad has not gone to school.

**Interrogative Sentence:** Has Asad gone to school?

**Interro-Negative Sentences:** Has Asad not gone to school?

## Present Perfect Continues:

**Identity:** رہا ہے، رہی ہے، رہیں ہیں --- وقت لازمی

### Formula:

**Assertive:** Subject + Helping Verb + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective + Since/For

**Negative:** Subject + has/have + not been + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective + Since/For

**Interrogative:** Has/Have + Subject + been + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective + Since/For + ?

**Interro-Negative:** Has/Have + Subject + not been + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective + Since/For+?

**Helping Verbs:** HAS BEEN, HAVE BEEN

- With He, She, It, Name (Singular) "HAS BEEN" comes.
- With I, We, You, They, Them etc. (Plural) "HAVE BEEN" comes.
- SINCE comes with a non particular time i.e. Morning, 2 O' Clock, 1987 etc.
- FOR comes with a particular time period i.e. 7 Hours, 15 Minutes, 30 Seconds etc.

### Example:

اسد صبح سے پڑھ رہا ہے۔

**Assertive/Affirmative Sentence:** Asad has been reading since morning.

**Negative Sentence:** Asad has not been reading since morning.

**Interrogative Sentence:** Has Asad been reading since morning?

**Interro-Negative Sentences:** Has Asad not been reading since morning?

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## Past Indefinite:

**Assertive:** Subject + Verb 2<sup>nd</sup> Form + Objective

**Negative:** Subject + did not + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form + Objective

**Interrogative:** Did + Subject + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form + Objective + ?

**Interro-Negative:** Did + Subject + Not + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form + Objective + ?

### Example:

اسد اسکول جا چکا ہے۔

**Assertive/Affirmative Sentence:**

Asad went to school.

**Negative Sentence:**

Asad did not go to school.

**Interrogative Sentence:**

Did Asad go to school?

**Interro-Negative Sentences:**

Did Asad not go to school?

## Past Continues:

**Identity:** رہا تھا، رہی تھی، رہے تھے

### Formula:

**Assertive:** Subject + Helping Verb + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective

**Negative:** Subject + Helping Verb + not + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective

**Interrogative:** Helping Verb + Subject + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective + ?

**Interro-Negative:** Helping Verb + Subject + Not + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective + ?

**Helping Verbs: WAS, WERE**

- With I, He, She, It, Name (Singular) "WAS" comes.
- With We, You, They, Them etc. (Plural) "WERE" comes.

### Example:

اسد اسکول جا رہا تھا۔

**Assertive/Affirmative Sentence:**

Asad was going to school.

**Negative Sentence:**

Asad was not going to school.

**Interrogative Sentence:**

Was Asad going to school?

**Interro-Negative Sentences:**

Was Asad not going to school?

**Assertive:** Subject + Helping Verb + Verb 3<sup>rd</sup> Form + Objective

**Negative:** Subject + Helping Verb + not + Verb 3<sup>rd</sup> Form + Objective

**Interrogative:** Helping Verb + Subject + Verb 3<sup>rd</sup> Form + Objective + ?

**Interro-Negative:** Helping Verb + Subject + Not + Verb 3<sup>rd</sup> Form + Objective + ?

Helping Verbs: HAD

### Example:

اسد اسکول جاچکا تھا۔

**Assertive/Affirmative Sentence:**

Asad had gone to school.

**Negative Sentence:**

Asad had not gone to school.

**Interrogative Sentence:**

Had Asad gone to school?

**Interro-Negative Sentences:**

Had Asad not gone to school?

## Past Perfect Continues:

**Identity:** رہا تھا، رہی تھی، رہے تھے --- وقت لازمی

### Formula:

**Assertive:** Subject + Helping Verb + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Since/For + Objective

**Negative:** Subject + had not been + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Since/For + Objective

**Interrogative:** Had + Subject + been + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Since/For + Objective + ?

**Interro-Negative:** Had + Subject + not been + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Since/For + Objective + ?

Helping Verbs: HAD BEEN

- SINCE comes with a non particular time i.e. Morning, 2 O' Clock, 1987 etc.
- FOR comes with a particular time period i.e. 7 Hours, 15 Minutes, 30 Seconds etc.

### Example:

اسد صبح سے پڑھ رہا تھا۔

**Assertive/Affirmative Sentence:**

Asad had been reading since morning.

**Negative Sentence:**

Asad had not been reading since morning.

**Interrogative Sentence:**

Had Asad reading since morning?

**Interro-Negative Sentences:**

Had Asad not been reading since morning?

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## Future Indefinite:

### Formula:

**Assertive:** Subject + Helping Verb + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form + Objective

**Negative:** Subject + Helping Verb + not + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form + Objective

**Interrogative:** Helping Verb + Subject + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form + Objective + ?

**Interro-Negative:** Helping Verb + Subject + Not + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form + Objective + ?

Helping Verbs: WILL, SHALL

- With I, We "SHALL" comes.
- With He, She, It, We, You, They, Them etc. "WILL" comes.

**Negative:** Subject + Helping Verb + not be + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective

**Interrogative:** Helping Verb + Subject + be + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective + ?

**Interro-Negative:** Helping Verb + Subject + Not be + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective + ?

Helping Verbs: WILL, SHALL

- With I, We "SHALL" comes.
- With He, She, It, We, You, They, Them etc. "WILL" comes.

**Interrogative:** Helping Verb + Subject + have + Verb 3<sup>rd</sup> Form + Objective + ?

**Interro-Negative:** Helping Verb + Subject + Not have + Verb 3<sup>rd</sup> Form + Objective + ?

Helping Verbs: WILL, SHALL

- With I, We "SHALL" comes.
- With He, She, It, We, You, They, Them etc. "WILL" comes.

### Example:

اسد اسکول جا چکا ہوگا۔

**Assertive/Affirmative Sentence:** Asad will have gone to school.

**Negative Sentence:** Asad will not have gone to school.

**Interrogative Sentence:** Will Asad have gone to school?

**Interrogative:** Helping Verb + Subject + have been + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective + Since/For+?

**Interro-Negative:** H.V + Subject + not have been + Verb 1<sup>st</sup> Form with (ing) + Objective + Since/For + ?
