**Subject: Earnest request to find Masood Janjua and other missing loved ones in Pakistan.**

Honorable Sir,

I congratulate you on becoming the President-Elect of the United States. If I was able to cast a vote, I would certainly cast in your favor because you give a new sense of hope to many people around the world. I know for you and for all Americans, family means “The Most” in your life. Similarly, family means the most to me and to all Pakistanis’. My letter today is all about “**family and their loved-ones**”.

My husband Masood Janjua is the most loving and vital part of our family. We got married in June 1989 and since then had all the happiness in the world. With two sons and a daughter, our life was full of love and fun. But our lives changed on July 30, 2005 when Masood was abducted on his way to Peshawar for a business trip. The love of my life was snatched away from me without any reason and I am left all alone to suffer, struggle and grief for my husband. In spite of trying hard and approaching the highest level personnel in Pakistan, I am still desperate and clueless for any news about Masood for over three years. Recently Aasim Qureshi, a UK based International Lawyer of Cage-Prisoners held a press conference in Pakistan on December 4, 2008 telling that he talked to senior military officials in Pakistan and was informed that **Masood is detained in Pakistan and could not be released because of the CIA’s involvement.**

Sir, please request the CIA to let me get in touch with my husband. Our family is desperate for him. He has been missing for over 3½ years. The children deserve to have their father with them. Our right to live peacefully and blissfully as a family has been taken away. Today, on December 10, 2008, the world celebrates the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary for the UN Universal Declaration of Human Rights. The first sentence of its preamble states, “Whereas recognition of the inherent dignity and of the equal and inalienable rights of all members of the human family is the foundation of freedom, justice and peace in the world.” Sir, please help our family.

Kindly show solidarity with the aggrieved victims of enforced disappearances and their families. We have high hopes that justice and human rights will prevail in your administration and morality, honor and human dignity will prosper in your leadership. Please take concrete measures to solve this dilemma for the families of thousands of lost love ones. Sir, as the President of the United States of America, you are a role model for the world and therefore are duty bound to respond to the cry for justice, by innocent aggrieved families of enforced disappearances; asking nothing but to be united with their long lost loved-ones.

I had no idea that my tireless struggles to find Masood will lead to a movement of Missing Persons in Pakistan, registering over 600 persons subjected to enforced disappearance as of December 3, 2008. Attached list shows some of the missing persons. Thousands of more honorable citizens of Pakistan are being abducted by intelligence agencies, for years without end and aren’t allowed any contact with their families. They are not given a chance of fair trial nor have access to any legal aid. They are constantly being tortured beyond the protection of all domestic and International laws. Unfortunately, short-sighted foreign policies created by the Bush administration and supported by the military dictator, General Musharraf of Pakistan in the last eight

years have sacrificed the respect for the Rule of Law, and lost all Ethical and Moral Values of Humanity. These policies have increased terrorism exponentially in Pakistan. In 2001, there was not a single suicide attack in Pakistan. Last year in 2007, there were over 60 attacks that claimed the lives of over 1400 people in Pakistan. There is a great urgency to undo the Human Rights Violations, Human Torture and Abuse of Power, which are a disgrace for both America and Pakistan.

Sir, pay homage to the love of a couple who was forcefully separated by the cruel and unjust forces of the world.

- Pay homage to the love of a wife who has never rested and carried out hundreds of protests, rallies, campaigns, conducted countless seminars, walks, sit ins, press conferences and traveled over half of the world in search of her husband.
- Pay homage to this divine feeling and this strongest of emotion called **“Love”** which will never allow a loving wife to give up. She will consider it an honor even if she has to lay down her life on the way of finding her husband.
- Pay homage to a selfless commitment, a fearless courage and a restless endeavors of a lone, helpless woman who has embarked on a great journey to help all missing persons get traced and released.

Martin Luther King Jr. said: **“Darkness can not drive out darkness; only light can do that. Hate can not drive out hate; only Love can do that.”** Sir with your most sincere efforts, let your **“Love”** for humanity do the magic of uniting our Loved-ones. Human today is the epitome of modernization yet he makes humanity suffer for its most basic right **“Love of the Loved-ones”**. Attached are a few letters from U.S. Congressman Earl Blumenauer, U.S. Congressman David Wu, U.S. Department of State and UK Minister of State, Lord Avebury regarding Masood’s disappearance. Kindly help us get justice by finding Masood. Thanks.

Please invite our family to visit the United States to share our journey with the U.S. Congress. It would be an honor and a privilege to meet you. Kindly help us reunite with our loved ones. Sir, we really need your help.

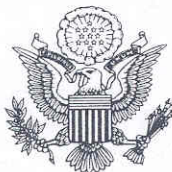

At the request of my constituent, Saba Ahmed, I am attempting to locate the whereabouts of Pakistani citizen, Masood Ahmed Janjua. Any assistance the Embassy can provide toward this end would be very welcomed.

I understand Mr. Janjua went missing in July 2005 and is thought to be detained in Rawalpindi, Pakistan. There are reports from earlier this year of his presence in Chaklala 10 Core, Rawalpindi, and in cell 20 I-9 in Islamabad. I am further informed that Mr. Janjua's father, Lt. Colonel Raja Ali Muhammad, served in the Pakistani Army for 25 years.

Mr. Janjua has aging parents, a wife, and three children who are desperate for news. I would appreciate any information you can provide. I am writing on behalf of Saba Ahmed who has requested my help in locating the whereabouts of Masood Ahmed Janjua, a Pakistani citizen. Any assistance that the Embassy may be able to provide would be greatly appreciated.

It is my understanding the Mr. Janjua went missing in July 2005; he is thought to be detained in Rawalpindi, Pakistan. Recent reports suggest that he may be located in Chaklala 10 Core, Rawalpindi, in cell 20 I-9 in Islamabad. Mr. Janjua's father, Lt. Colonel Raja Ali Muhammad, reportedly served in the Pakistani Army for 25 years.

Mr. Janjua has aging parents, a wife, and three children who are exceedingly concerned about his safety and desperate for news. Thank you for your moving October 15 letter about the missing in Pakistan and your husband's disappearance in 2005. I regret that it was not possible for you to travel to the United States as planned in September 2008.

The Department of State is deeply concerned about the fate of those who have disappeared in Pakistan in recent years. We bring such cases to light in our annual Country Reports on Human Rights Practices. In my discussions with senior Pakistani officials, I have also emphasized the importance of an independent judiciary for the health of Pakistan's democracy and the protection of human rights.

I extend to you my deepest sympathy for the disappearance of your husband and my hope that your separation from him comes to an end very, very soon.

Thank you for your letter of 19 September on behalf of Mrs Amina Janjua, wife of Mr Masood Janjua, and the issue of enforced disappearances in Pakistan.

I share your concerns about enforced disappearances in Pakistan. FCO officials discussed ways of addressing this continuing human rights concern with Mrs Janjua and Ms Pastakia of Amnesty International at a recent meeting. As well as Mrs Janjua's personal case, discussion at this meeting also covered the independence of the judiciary in Pakistan. As human rights organisations have noted, the judiciary have been instrumental in securing the release of detainees from illegal detention. We have continually stressed that we attach great importance to the respect for the independence of the judiciary as a cornerstone of the rule of law. This is a critical part of the strong institutional framework required for a sustained democratic transition in Pakistan and is essential to safeguard human rights in the longer term.

In April, Pakistan's Law Minister, Farooq Naek announced that the government was collecting details of disappeared persons and that it would release information about them. This follows the repeated calls we have made on the Government of Pakistan both *bilaterally and with our EU partners* to release all remaining detainees or place them on an open legal process. We are monitoring the Government of Pakistan's progress in gathering information about the disappeared persons and welcome the statement made by the Pakistani representative at the Universal Periodic Review that Pakistan will accede to the International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearances. We look forward to seeing urgent ratification and implementation of this instrument and encourage reform of judicial processes to prevent such detentions in the future.

**What happened?**

On 30<sup>th</sup> July 2005, Mr. Masood Ahmed Janjua and Mr. Faisal Faraz left from Rawalpindi for Peshawar on a bus. They availed the booked seat but we do not know if they reached Peshawar. Missing report was lodged in Westridge police station on 7<sup>th</sup> Sep, 2005. Chief Justice of Pakistan took suo-motto notice of Masood's abduction in December, 2005. The case is still going on in the Supreme Court, H.R.C 965/2005. Even the President of Pakistan was contacted and written applications were sent to DG ISI, DG MI, DG IB, Interior Minister Mr. Sher Pao, Mr. Prime Minister and to the Vice Chief of Army staff. Maj. Gen. Safqaat M.S to the President admitted on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2006 that Masood is alive and was seen by an informer. Released persons as interviewed by Mrs. Amina Janjua confirmed Masood's presence in the ISI custody in Rawalpindi, Islamabad, Karachi & Attock fort. Afraid of being picked up again and harassed the released persons cannot disclose their identity.

**Family:**

Masood's father Lt. Col Raja Ali Muhammad served in the Army for 25 years. He and the President Musharraf were together in S.S.G and know each other very well. The President promised to trace Masood but so far nothing has been done. Both the parents are old and ailing. Masood's old parents, wife (Amina) and three young children (Muhammad 17 years, Ali 16 years and Aishah 12) are in an extremely miserable condition.



## September 2006 Protests

When all efforts bore no result of tracing Mr. Janjua, Mrs. Amina Janjua along with other families of missing persons started peacefully protesting on the roads, since Sep 1<sup>st</sup> 2006. No stone has been left unturned, Supreme Court, Parliament House, President House, Prime Minister House, GHQ Rawalpindi, ISI Head Quarter, Zero-point on every venue the peaceful protests demonstration were carried out and the process still continues. People from all over Pakistan who had previously been afraid or harassed, forced to keep stay quiet are now joining every day to strengthen this caravan of missing person's families. Their cases are regularly being filed with Supreme Court. At the time of last hearing on 1<sup>st</sup> Nov, 2007 the number of Missing Persons was nearly 500.

## Important Evidence Found

On 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2007 evidence was provided by Deputy Attorney General obtained from the lawyer of Dr. Imran Munir. On the basis of which a fresh c.m.a was filed in the H.R.C 965/2005 (case of 43 missing persons including Masood Janjua). It was a hand written 10 paged statement of Dr. Imran Munir a young Doctor settled in Malaysia. He was abducted by ISI early in 2006 and tortured badly on account of some personal grudge with an ISI officer. He was near to death when he was advised by the guards of 12 solitary confinement in Chaklala, Rawalpindi that you will die like this, it is better you exchange views with inmates opposite to your cell and understand that to save your life you will have to give the statement they are asking for, or else they will kill you; or hand you over to U.S.A but they will never release you. The person opposite to Dr. Imran's cell was, as he writes himself... **"a businessman Masood Janjua of Rawalpindi."** the clipping of the statement is attached.

weeks and beside that they didn't let me sleep every day except 3 hours a day and let me stand almost 15 hours a day in chains on my both hands and both feet. They started giving me tremendous amount of extra red chilies in my food every day and due to that I got external hemorrhoids and fresh blood started coming out through my stools and also got stomach ulcer. They didn't let me shower and didn't let me change my dress and therefore I got scabies.

✓ The guards who were guarding the 12 solitary confinement cells told me that there is only one way to get out from the hands of ISI is to co-operate with them and give them the statement the way they want, otherwise they will <sup>not</sup> release me and they might handed over me to the USA custody in Guantanamo Bay or they might torture me further and they might kill me but will never release me. First I didn't believe them but when they let me spoke to the other three inmates that was opposite to my cell and when I heard their stories that how they were apprehended by ISI and how they were <sup>never</sup> charged and never taken to any court, then I believed them and realised that it is the only way to get out from the ISI custody to co-operated with them. Out of these three inmates there was a businessman Masood Janjua of Rawalpindi

Ever since then Dr. Imran Munir was being called on every hearing in Supreme Court regarding this case. First time when he was called by Supreme Court he was in Mangla in Army detention facility, since he was sentenced 8 years prison by Army field Court Marshal. He was called to give statement regarding Masood Janjua but his lawyers complained about his tortures and failing health, therefore he was sent to the PIMS hospital under Islamabad Police custody. After every fifteen days there was hearing but he was never asked to give statement. On the hearing of 1<sup>st</sup> Nov, 2007 Dr. Imran submitted that my



statement is ready, however the Chief Justice remarked if we are going to take the statement of Dr. Imran Munir a lot of true stories will be in picture regarding the illegal practices and atrocities committed by Agencies and Army. We don't want to go till that limit because we want to save the institution. However, if the detained persons are not released by 13<sup>th</sup> of Nov, 07 (which is the last chance given to the Government and its Agencies) the statement of Dr. Imran will be recorded on the 13<sup>th</sup> November, 2007. The responsibility will be fixed and we will be forced to call the Generals in order to proceed by Law. The efforts are being made to communicate to the Agencies through Attorney General to compromise by releasing these illegal detainees including Masood Janjua. So that families can be given some relief and reputation of the Army be saved.

### **The issue of the Enforced Disappearance:**

Now it is Pakistan's burning issue. It must be resolved on priority basis more so for the sake of honor and dignity of our country which is at stake. In the "War on Terror" Human Rights are badly being violated and the reputation of our homeland is badly damaged because of the averted role of our Army and Intelligence Agencies.

### **New Evidence Found:**

On December 5, 2007, an uncle of Nazir Khalis visited with some great news to tell. Uncle told that he struggled hard to recover his nephew from the custody of Intelligence Agencies. Nazir Khalis belonging to Hayatabad Peshawar was finally released after four years. Nazir Khalis confirmed seeing Masood Janjua and Faisal Faraz while being in secret detention himself. The location was the same as mentioned by Dr. Imran Munir, i.e. Chaklala basement in Rawalpindi. Nazir Khalis happened to see Masood and Faisal and came to know them while being taken to toilet and when the hood on their head was either being removed or being put on at certain times. The time of the meeting is also same that is January 2007 which was confirmed by Dr. Imran Munir. This evidence further confirms the presence of both Masood Janjua and Faisal Faraz with the secret agencies based in Chaklala in January 2007. There are now undeniable evidences against the agencies and further Nazir is ready to give his legal statement in this regard.

Recently Aasim Qureshi, UK based International Lawyer of Cage-Prisoners held a press conference in Pakistan on December 4, 2008 telling that he talked to senior military officials in Pakistan and was informed that both Masood and Faisal are detained in Pakistan and could not be released because of the CIA's involvement. The Ministry of Foreign affairs is thus contacted to find out facts and help us get him released. There is authentic news of Masood's presence in Chaklala 10 Corps, Hamza Camp Rawalpindi and in cell 20, I-9 Islamabad from **April to November 2008**. His family has serious concerns about the mental and physical well being of Masood after prolonged illegal detention and torture. We appeal to the world and all the Pakistani authorities to play their role for Masood's immediate and respectable release.
